Help fight child hunger in New York City! Work with Hunger Free America to promote participation in free summer meals programming.

Hunger Free America is a national nonprofit group building a nonpartisan, grass-roots membership movement to enact the policies and programs needed to end domestic hunger and ensure that all Americans have sufficient access to nutritious food. Our long-term goal is not just to ameliorate the problem, but also to build the people's movement necessary to enact the economic and public policies needed to end hunger entirely. Given that hunger drains our economy and tears at our moral and civic fabric, we know that eliminating it will boost the nation both economically and spiritually. Towards that end, we've adopted the motto: "Ending hunger lifts us all."

During the summer, Hunger Free America's Child Nutrition Department places a multitude of AmeriCorps VISTA members across the country at various hunger-fighting institutions with a focus on combatting child hunger during the summertime. Once school lets out, millions of children no longer receive school meals and face tremendous obstacles accessing the Summer Food Service Program, which offers free meals for any child under the age of 18.

The Position – *Accepting applications now, deadline to apply is May 17th*

The [Hunger Free America Summer Associate Program](#) aims to create more food secure families and support nutritious food choices. Summer Associate members will expand and support the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and nutrition education programming; improve awareness of nutritious food options at farmers' markets and the use of SNAP benefits at farmers' markets; and raise awareness of and eliminate barriers to SNAP and other food/nutrition-access services. We're looking for individuals to help us with the following tasks:

- Performing community outreach – **must be comfortable doing canvassing in neighborhoods across NYC, being outdoors during summer weather, and interacting with children and parents to raise awareness**
- Researching, contacting, and partnering with community organizations in target neighborhoods for summer meals outreach
- Contacting elected officials, community stakeholders, and emergency food providers to raise awareness on summer meals
- Implementing summer meals social media outreach

- Creating summer meals outreach materials

The ideal candidate will have:

- Interest in child hunger issues
- Experience working with diverse communities
- Adaptability and willingness to work on all kinds of projects
- Ability to work independently and as a member of a team
- Reliability, responsibility, and a good work ethic
- Good organizational and communications skills
- Familiarity with New York City and ability to use public transit
- **Fluency or conversational-level Spanish, Mandarin, Arabic, Bengali, Cantonese, or other languages common in NYC is a strong asset**

Time Commitment:

This is a short-term, 8-week, full-time position beginning June 23rd, 2019 and ending August 16th, 2019. You are expected to be available for the needs of your community and project at all times. Summer Associates may be able to have a part-time job outside of service hours; however, they will discuss this with their supervisor prior to starting their position.

Housing:

You are responsible for finding your own housing. No housing allowance will be provided.
